Humanity is currently on a global journey from patriarchal violence to solidarity, sustainability, and sustainable human development.

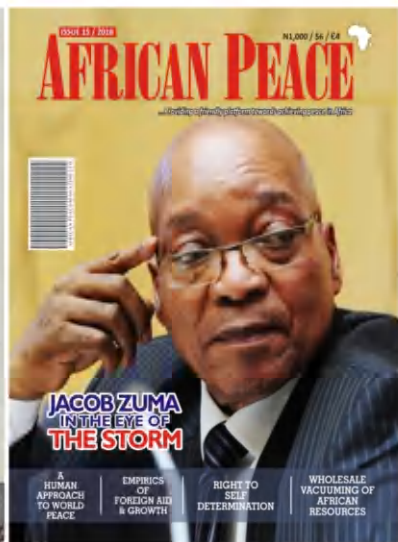
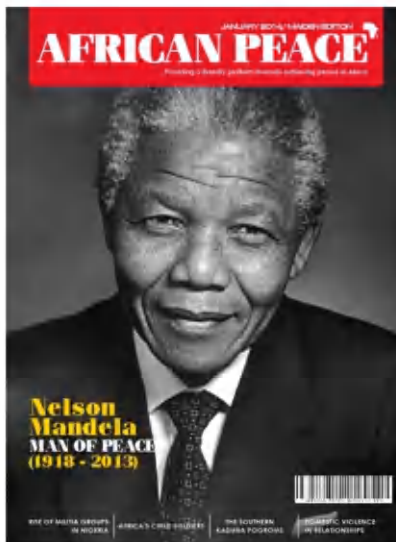
